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
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HOLISTIC LEARNING AT GCIS

Every activity, both inside and outside the classroom, facilitate to empower students to become meaningful contributors to a global society and insist that they transform into the best they can possibly be.




A distinctive characteristic of GCIS is its friendly,

 - **Events and Competitions:** Class events, inter-house competitions, and school-wide events foster loyalty, healthy competition, and showcase student talents.


Guest Interactions: Eminent guests and personalities frequently visit our campus for meaningful interactions with students.


